Facts About Alzheimer's Disease



Today there are more than 5 million Americans

who have Alzheimer's Disease. There are approximately 700,000 (seven hundred thousand) Americans with Early Onset Alzheimer's disease, a form that can develop as early as 40 years of age, or even younger. The more common form of the disease usually develops from the age of 65 and older.

About one out of eight Americans 65 years of age is afflicted with Alzheimer's Disease. The percentages rise sharply every five years of life.

Each of us has a 50% risk of developing Alzheimer's by the time we're 80-85 years of age. That's a 50/50 chance of being personally affected by this horrifying disease. Can any of us afford to gamble with our future?
